## Low profile linear silicon NPN RF bipolar transistor



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## Product description

The BFP650F is a RF bipolar transistor based on SiGe:C technology that is part of Infineon's established sixth generation transistor family. Its transition frequency  $f_T$  of 42 GHz along with its linearity characteristics make the device suitable for oscillators. It remains cost competitive without compromising on ease of use.












**Figure 3** Transition frequency  $f_T = f(I_C)$ ,  $f = 1$  GHz,  $V_{CE}$  = parameter




**Figure 4** Collector base capacitance  $C_{CB} = f(V_{CB})$ ,  $f = 1$  MHz




**Figure 5** Gain  $G_{ma}$ ,  $G_{ms}$ ,  $|S_{21}|^2 = f(f)$ ,  $V_{CE} = 3$  V,  $I_C = 80$  mA








**Figure 8** Package outline
