

Low voltage fast-switching NPN power transistor

The resulting transistor shows exceptional high gain performance coupled with very low saturation voltage.




Figure 1. Internal schematic diagram






Figure 4. Collector-emitter saturation voltage





Figure 6. Base-emitter saturation voltage


Figure 7. Base-emitter on voltage

Figure 9. Resistive load switching time







Figure 10. Resistive load switching time

Figure 11. Inductive load switching time







Figure 12. Inductive load switching time



Figure 13. Resistive load switching test circuit




