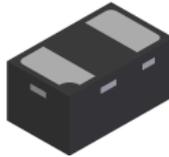

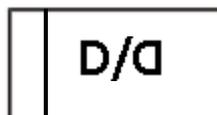

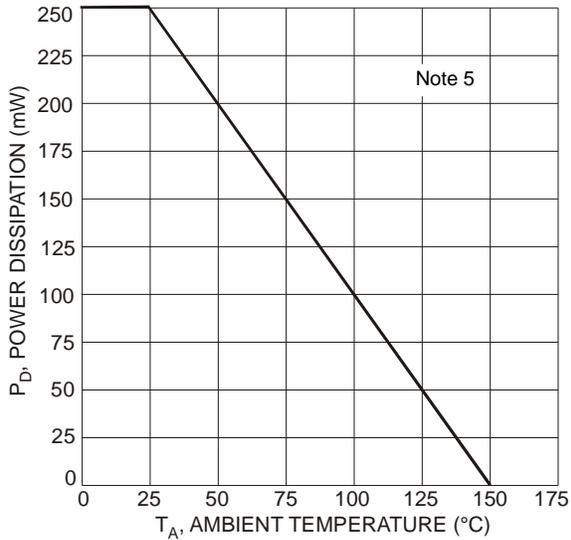


Figure 1 Power Derating Curve

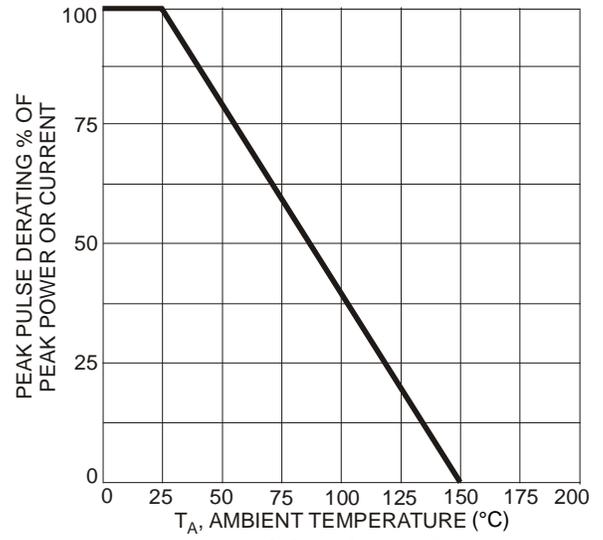


Figure 2 Pulse Derating Curve

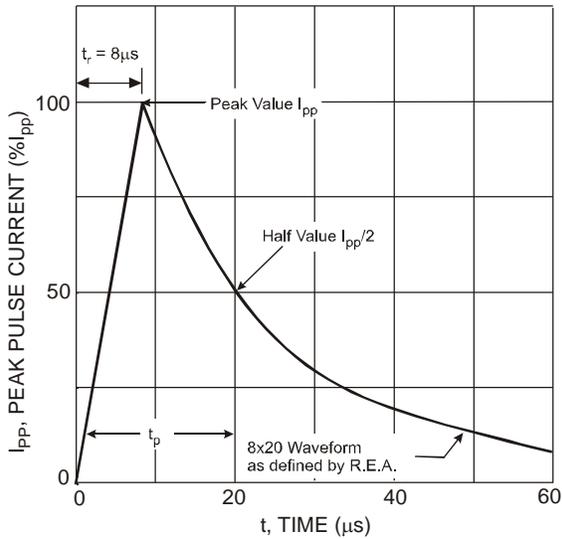


Figure 3 Pulse Waveform

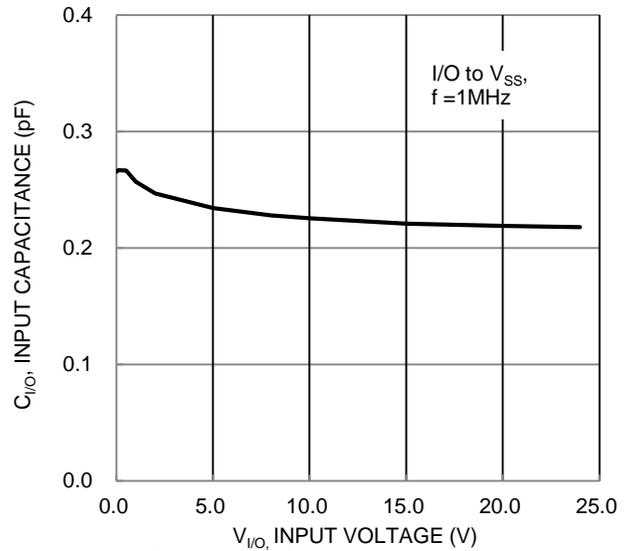


Figure 4 Input Capacitance vs. Input Voltage

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
